Subject : Conflict Minerals

To whoever it may concern,

As a result of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and the Conflict Minerals rules adopted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (the « SEC »), many public companies and their supply base are required to make disclosures regarding whether « conflict minerals » used to manufacture their products originated in the Democratic Republic of Congo (« DRC ») or the adjoining countries, as defined below (« Covered Countries »). These « conflict minerals » consist of columbite-tantalite, cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, which are initially limited to **talalum, tin, gold, and tungsten** (collectively, the « Conflict Minerals »).

Industeel Belgium and France, fully owned subsidiaries of ArcelorMittal Group will not purchase material that is not « DRC Conflict Free » (as defined by the applicable SEC rules) from any suppliers.

The « Covered Countries » are the Democratic Republic of Congo (« DRC ») and the following adjoining countries : a country that shares an internationally recognized border with the DRC, which presently includes Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia.

## CONFIRMATION OF DRC CONFLICT FREE STATUS

By countersigning below Industeel (“Supplier”) hereby certifies that all material it has supplied to its customers on and after January 31, 2013 is “DRC conflict free” as follows (*check applicable option(s)*):

The materials supplied by Supplier do not contain or utilize **tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold** (collectively, “Conflict Minerals”).

The materials supplied to customers on and after January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013 that contain or utilize any Conflict Minerals do not originate from any of the Covered Countries (as defined above). Supplier has implemented procedures to identify and monitor the origin of materials (other than those from recycled or scrap sources) that are produced with Conflict Minerals.

The materials supplied to customers on and after January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013 that contain or utilize any Conflict Minerals are from recycled or scrap sources.
