INFORMATION TO VISITORS

How your personal data are processed?

Data controller

As part of your visit, ArcelorMittal Industeel Belgium, whose registered office is located at 266 rue de Châtelet 6030 Marchienne-au-Pont, processes your personal data..

Data protection officer

A Data Protection Officer has been appointed to the Data Protection Authority and can be contacted to answer any questions you may have regarding the processing of your personal data at **dpo.industeelbelgique@arcelormittal.com**

Targets of the processing of your personal data

It is necessary to process some personal data in order to be able to organize the delivery of a badge in accordance with the safety requirements of the site.

Legal basis for processing

The verification of the identity of visitors for the issuance of a badge is made necessary by the Belgian Law of 2 October 2017 regulating private and special security. The security service belongs to category 13: residual category of personal control.

Data processed

To be able to give you a badge, we need the following data: surname, first name, employer, date of arrival and name of the person accompanying you.

You may be asked for your identity card for a live verification of the consistency of the information provided.

Data retention period

Your personal data are kept for a maximum of 13 months. Then they are erased.

Transfert out of the European Union

Your personal data are not transferred outside the European Union.

Recipients/Data Accessors

Only people who hold the following positions can have access to your personal data: Seris post manager, members of the badge issuing headquarter, security and infrastructure manager as well as his deputy and the staff present who work on the SERIS software.

Rights on personal data

You can access your data, rectify it, request its deletion or exercise your right to restrict the processing of your data.

You can also oppose to the processing of your data;
